Not Enough: Locked in another back and forth affair with Billings on Sunday, Helena had three separate leads, and couldn't hold any of them. Up 5-4 going into the ninth, Helena surrendered their third lead of the day on a two run home run by Pabel Manzanero. With the loss, Helena is now three back of Billings for first place in the Northern division.

Tonight's Duel: Caden Lemons makes his first start in the Pioneer League after spending parts of his first two professional seasons with the AZL Brewers. A 2017 2nd round selection, Lemons is the 15th ranked prospect in the Brewers system by MLB Pipeline. Eris Filpo goes for Grand Junction, making his tenth start. Filpo spent each of his first two seasons in the Dominican Summer League.

All The Stars Are Golden: Four Helena Brewers made the 2018 Pioneer League All Star Team, which played against the Northwest League All Star Team on Tuesday night. LG Castillo and David Fry were starters in left field and catcher respectively, while Chad McClanahan came off the bench and Wilfred Salaman out of the bullpen. Fry went 1 for 2 with an RBI, while Castillo went 2 for 5. Salaman pitched a scoreless inning out of the bullpen.

Award Season: Helena has won two league awards this season, as Aaron Ashby and Victor Castaneda earned Pitcher of the Week awards in back to back weeks. Ashby earned it with seven shutout innings on July 21st against Ogden, while Castaneda earned his with six shutout innings on July 27th in Great Falls.

Ward Of The Double: Friday night Je'Von Ward went 4 for 5 with three doubles, reaching base in each of his first four at bats. Ward is the first Brewer to hit three doubles in a game and is the second Brewer with a four hit game.

Oh Look Who It Is: Brewers 2018 1st Round selection Brice Turang was promoted to Helena prior to August 1st's game and went 3 for 4 with three singles in his Helena debut on August 1st. The former LSU commit hit .319 in 13 games in the AZL. His father Brian played parts of two seasons in the majors with the Seattle Mariners. He has four sisters that all played college athletics.

David Fry, Road Warrior: All but one of David Fry's home runs in 2018 have come on the road. He has seven RBI on the road in six second half games.

Flurry Of Moves: Prior to tonight's game, the Brewers announced the promotion of pitcher Wilfred Salaman to Class A Wisconsin, along with infielder Chad McClanahan. To fill the three spots, the Brewers added three pitchers from the AZL Brewers, which include Caden Lemons, Michele Vassalotti, and Joel Pinto. Lemons was Milwaukee's 2nd round draft selection in 2017, while Vassalotti becomes the youngest player on the Helena roster (born 8/2/2000).

Brewer Prospecting: Three players on Helena's current roster are currently ranked in MLB Pipeline's top 30 Brewers prospects. Shortstop Brice Turang is 4th, while pitcher Caden Lemons is ranked 15th. Outfielder Je'Von Ward is ranked 26th. Ward, a former USC commit, is the nephew of former NFL safety Mark Carrier, who also played at USC.

Researching The Rockies: Grand Junction has 14 members of the 2018 Rockies draft class on their roster, with four of those players being taken in the top five rounds. Ryan Rolison (6) and Grant Lavigne (8) are their two Top 30 prospects, both taken in the first round of this year's draft.

Chatting With Caden: Caden Lemons makes his first start in Helena after starting the 2018 season with the AZL Brewers. A 2nd Round selection in the 2017 draft out of Vestavia Hills High School in Birmingham, Alabama, Lemons is the 15th ranked prospect in the Brewers system by MLB Pipeline. He turned down a commitment to Ole Miss in order to sign with the Brewers.

2018 So Far: After pitching just 2.2 professional innings in 2017, Lemons is off to a good start in 2018, having allowed just two earned runs in 13 innings. While he has not pitched more than three innings in an appearance, Lemons hasn't allowed more than three hits in an appearance.

History With Rockies Affiliates: This will be Lemons' first career appearance against a Rockies affiliate as Colorado does not have an affiliate in the Arizona League.

Meet Michele: Michele Vassalotti joins the Helena Brewers after spending the first seven appearances of the season with the AZL Brewers. A Venezuelan native, he is the youngest player to appear in Helena this season. He signed with the Brewers organization in June of last year at age 16.

Putting Up Zeroes: Vassalotti had 16 straight innings in the AZL this season with no runs allowed. Through his first 21 innings of the season, he has surrendered just one total run.

The Advanced Numbers: In 2017, Vassalotti had a ground ball percentage of 54.2%, and this season it is 47.6%. Opponents pulled 55.5% of the balls put in play against him last season, while this year it is 42.4%

History With Rockies Affiliates: This will be Vassalotti's first career appearance against a Rockies affiliate as Colorado does not have an affiliate in the Arizona League. He did not face the DSL Rockies.

2018 Coaching Staff



Manager - Nestor Corredor (3rd Season)

Nestor Corredor, 34, returns to Helena to manage the Brewers for a third season in 2018. Corredor played seven professional Minor League seasons in the Brewers organization from 2002-2008, hitting .211 with 10 HR and 109 RBI in 332 games. This will be his fifth overall season in Helena after playing for the team as a catcher in 2004, returning as a pitcher in 2008 and managing the team in 2016 & 2017. Over the course of his managerial career, Corredor has compiled a record of 224-300 (.427) in eight seasons spent with the Rookie Dominican Summer League Brewers (2010-2012), AZL Brewers (2013-2015) and Helena Brewers (2016-2017).



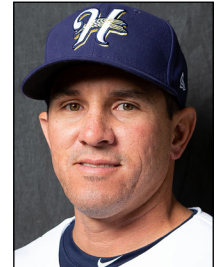
Pitching Coach - Rolando Valles (2nd Straight Season, 4th Overall)

Rolando Valles, 38, returns to Helena for his second consecutive season. Valles served as Helena's pitching coach in 2014-2015 under Tony Diggs and worked as a Latin Liaison for the Brewers from 2008-2013. In 2016 he was the pitching coach for the AZL Brewers. An undrafted free agent in 1997 by the Houston Astros, Valles played seven seasons of minor league and independent league ball from 2000-2007, going 43-26 with a 3.72 ERA in 189 appearances, 73 of them starts.



Hitting Coach - Liu Rodriguez (3rd Season)

Liu Rodríguez, 41, returns to the Brewers organization for his fifth season and his third year in Helena. In 2015, Rodríguez served as a coach for Class-A Wisconsin, and in 2014 he worked with the Rookie Arizona Brewers. A former middle infielder, Rodríguez spent seven seasons in the White Sox organization from 1995 to 2001, making his Major League debut in 1999. The native of Caracas, Venezuela batted .237 with 1 HR and 12 RBI in 39 career Major League Games.



Bullpen Coach - Jim Henderson (1st Season)

Former MLB pitcher Jim Henderson joins Helena as their bullpen coach for the 2018 season, his first as a professional coach. A Calgary, Alberta native, Henderson was a 26th round selection by the Expos in 2003, and made his major league debut with Milwaukee in 2012. His final season in the big leagues was in 2016 when he made 44 appearances with the New York Mets.



Athletic Trainer - Matt Deal (2nd Season)

Matt Deal, 25, starts his fourth season in the Brewers organization and second in Helena. A native of Evergreen Park, IL, Deal attended Marquette University and graduated with a degree in Athletic Training in 2015. He was hired by the Brewers in 2015 and spent his first summer in the Dominican Republic with the Dominican Summer League Brewers. In 2016, Deal moved back stateside and worked for the AZL Brewers as the teams' athletic trainer.



Strength & Conditioning Specialist - Lucas Weitzel (1st Season)

Lucas Weitzel, 23, comes to the Brewers from the University of Florida, where he earned a BS in applied physiology & kinesiology and a MS in human performance. During his time at UF, he worked with the baseball, softball, football, track & field, swimming & diving, and volleyball teams. His father Brad, is currently the bench coach for the University of Florida, and has been in baseball for 39 years, most notably with the Minnesota Twins, as he signed and/or drafted 19 future big leaguers in 16 years as the Twins' Florida area scout.
